
Members of the appeals committee have become increasingly concerned about the lack of enforcement at the main gate. Specifically, that vehicles are routinely granted access to the community via the "decal" lane, yet the vehicles have no decals, and the drivers are not questioned and simply waived through.

We have heard from many homeowners and/or tenants during our hearings that they almost *never* needed a sticker, pass or valid ID to go through the gate, and that certain guards always waive them through. We have not heard these same comments about enforcement at the other two gates. Vince is aware of these allegations/complaints. Most of us have witnessed the activity described by the homeowners/tenants, and a dozen or more people have approached me confirming/complaining of the hand-signs from within the booth while the person is looking the opposite direction.

From time to time different members of the committee have offered constructive suggestions to the officers relative to his/her interaction with homeowners, the issuance of a citation, and proper note-taking within the citation. This is generally done in the presence of either Vince or Mike at our monthly meetings.
