The parks and beaches committee meet to discuss the ongoing and proposed projects that affect Canyon Lake's Parks and Beaches. Our proposals are recommended from the community and the parks and beaches committee.

Roadrunner Park

This project is to construct permanent restroom facilities for Roadrunner Park. The city has approved the plans with ADA access.

Eastport

The project has been completed. Improvements were made to the parking lot for trailer and car parking. Improvements to the launch ramp have been completed and the berm area has been landscaped

Indian Beach

This park is being used for events, picnicking and swimming.

The parks and beaches committee is planning for a children's play area with play equipment and also shaded areas, picnic tables, benches, swim area, outdoor shower, boat dock, improve the barbeque area and add ADA access. The committee is meeting with Schmidt Design to review the conceptual drawings for the play area.

Outrigger Park

Conceptual plans are under consideration by the PBC to supply and install play equipment at this site.

Sunset Beach

Conceptual plans are underway, in conjunction with the Tennis Committee to improve the park from the Tennis Courts to the beach area. The committee has heard a proposal for a smoking ban at this park.

Holiday Harbor

Plans have been introduced to the committee to add an amphitheater to the Park for theater events. The plans were forwarded to Long Range planning.
