RE: APPROVAL – Rule Revision GR.5.6m Headlights and Taillights Required After Sunset and / or Before Sunrise

Background

Staff has received complaints of golf carts equipped with off road lights blinding drivers in opposing lanes of traffic. To promote safer driving conditions the following proposed rule would outlaw off road lights, light bars, etc. from being used on golf carts operating within the Community. As a reference, California Vehicle Code (24411) requires that vehicles equipped with off road lights have said lights covered and turned off while driving on streets.
