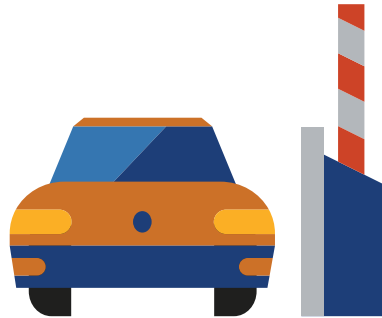

## HOW DOES RFID WORK?



Each vehicle has a unique Radio Frequency chip affixed to its windshield which controls gate entry. The gate arm will only open for vehicles with activated chips.

## RFID ACCESS BENEFITS

- >> Precise tracking and control of community access
- >> Provides efficient and fast entry into community
- >> Access can be turned on/off by management with click of a button
- >> Reduces human error associated with the visual inspection of decals
- >> Allows staff to focus more on verifying identities since there is no need to manually operate the gate

Estimated **12,000 vehicles** come through the gates every day (**400,000 annually**). **So far** 70% of members have RFID on their vehicles.

## RFID SAVES ⌚ & \$

- Eliminates costs associated with issuing annual vehicle decals
- Allows staffing levels to be adjusted on peak and non-peak hours

LED lane identification signage is coming soon that will allow lane change functionality for additional guest lanes during busy times.

**Utilizing RFID during these peak traffic times is quicker.**
