# JULY 4<sup>TH</sup> REMINDERS

July 4<sup>th</sup> is one of the Canyon Lake's busiest holidays! The population soars by thousands as residents host parties and barbecues all throughout the community. Canyon Lake has arguably the best fireworks show in the entire county of Riverside, which makes it an even more attractive destination for our residents and their guests.

## TRAFFIC & ROAD CLOSURES

### BEFORE THE SHOW

Beginning at 12 p.m. on July 4 per the Fire Marshal there is **No Parking** or viewing on any launch ramps or roads leading to launch ramp.

#### Happy Camp

- At 2 p.m., Longhorn Drive will close at Strawberry Lane to Happy Camp. Only Longhorn Drive residents past Strawberry Lane, guests at Happy Camp, or emergency vehicles may pass. Guests should be prepared to show their guest passes with their host's address, or camping pass if they are staying at Happy Camp.
- All traffic (including pedestrian traffic) to Happy Camp is stopped at 8:30 p.m.

The following closures will occur at 8:30 p.m., 30 minutes before the show:

- Lighthouse Drive at Vacation Drive to the Lodge
- Canyon Club Drive at Canyon Lake Drive North
- Main Causeway from Village Way Drive to Vacation Drive
- Blue Teal Drive will close once causeway is closed
- No parking on Main, North or Longhorn causeways

### AFTER THE SHOW

Below are reminders to help make exiting Holiday Harbor and Lodge areas easier. Community Patrol will be directing vehicles to

the quickest community exit, please keep in mind this could be in an alternate direction of your desired exit.

- Pedestrian traffic will be given priority along Canyon Club Drive and the Main Causeway in the first 30 minutes after the show.
- Village Way Drive - Vehicles (including golf carts) exiting Village Way Drive after the fireworks show will only be able to turn right onto Canyon Lake Drive South.
- Exiting the Lodge - Vehicles (including golf carts) will be required to exit onto Lighthouse Drive. From Lighthouse Drive, vehicles may turn left or right onto Vacation Drive.
- Vacation Drive Stop Sign - At the stop sign corner of Vacation Drive and Canyon Lake Drive North, vehicles exiting the show will only be able to make a left turn onto Canyon Lake Drive towards the East Gate.

## COMMUNITY ACCESS

Community Patrol will have extra staff on hand at all three gates to help move the flow of traffic through the gates as quickly as possible. All gates will have additional staff walking the line to assist guests with accessing the community.

- **Main & East Gates:** RFID lanes will be open to residents with RFID transponder and residents with vehicle decal. The other two lanes at these gates will be open for guests or residents.
- **North Gate:** Both lanes at North Gate will be for guests or residents.

The fireworks show begins at approximately 9 p.m. and they are launched from Skipper's Island. Spectators can tune into 99.9 FM to hear music synchronized to the fireworks show from anywhere around the lake.

# JULY 4<sup>TH</sup> REMINDERS

## INFORMATION FOR YOUR GUESTS

Those inviting guests into the community are encouraged to utilize the e-pass service. Members can log into their dwellingLIVE account online or through the mobile app and email their guest a pass. Guests can print the pass ahead of time, or the gate attendant can scan the pass on their smart phone. Guests will still need to provide their valid driver's license along with the e-pass. For guests who did not print the pass, the gate attendant will issue a parking pass which will need to be displayed on the dashboard during their visit.

It is important to remind your guests that they must have a valid driver's license in their possession when entering the community. Also, advise your guests to know your address, this will help the Community Patrol verify their information quicker at the gates.

## BOATING REMINDERS

### Boat Registration

Unregistered boats are not permitted on the lake. Marine Patrol will be verifying boats for current registration at all launch ramps. Unregistered boats are subject to a \$500 citation. Those who need to have a safety inspection completed on their boats in order to register them should call Marine Patrol at 951.244.6841 x415 to schedule an appointment.

### Skippers Island

Skippers Island is closed Sunday, June 30 through Friday, July 5.

### Gas Dock

The gas dock will close at 4 p.m. on July 4.

### Boating on July 4

After 12 p.m. there will be no towing on the main lake, and City Code Enforcement along with Marine Patrol will hold boats 450 feet from Skippers Island.

### Boating During Fireworks

Boats must maintain a safe distance from Skippers Island during the fireworks. If you are boating, please pay attention to the temporary red buoys with lights around

Skippers Island. City Code Enforcement along with Marine Patrol will hold boats 450 feet from the buoys. The firework show will not begin unless all boats are within a safe distance from Skippers Island and the on-site Fire Marshal announces "All Clear".

## PARK & BEACH HOURS

**Park and beach hours are 6 a.m. to 10 p.m. on July 4 only.** Please note, that any personal items left at parks or beaches before/after park hours will be removed. Please call the Canyon Lake POA at 951.244.6841 to inquire about lost items.

All picnic tables at Holiday Harbor are reserved through the lottery system. However, the remainder of Holiday Harbor (including the amphitheater) is available on a first-come basis. Portable tables, chairs, and canopies are acceptable.

## POOL HOURS

The pool will have modified hours from 6 a.m. to 8 p.m. and all activities at the pool are canceled for the day. The pool will close promptly at 8 p.m. for the fireworks show, no one will be allowed in the pool deck area. Although the pool will be closed, spectators are welcome to watch the fireworks from Sunset Beach and the walkway around the pool, as well as other waterfront parks that have a view toward Skipper's Island in the main lake.

## TAKING RESPONSIBILITY

Residents are reminded the prime member is responsible for the actions of his or her family, guests, renters and lessees, this also includes any citations. Prime members are responsible to know the Canyon Lake POA's Rules & Regulations and are asked to be respectful of those in authority who are trying to enforce those rules and safety for everyone. The Canyon Lake POA and City of Canyon Lake ask that everyone cooperate with those in authority to help ensure a safe holiday. The personal safety and enjoyment of all residents and guests is top priority, and strict enforcement of the law will be applied throughout the weekend.

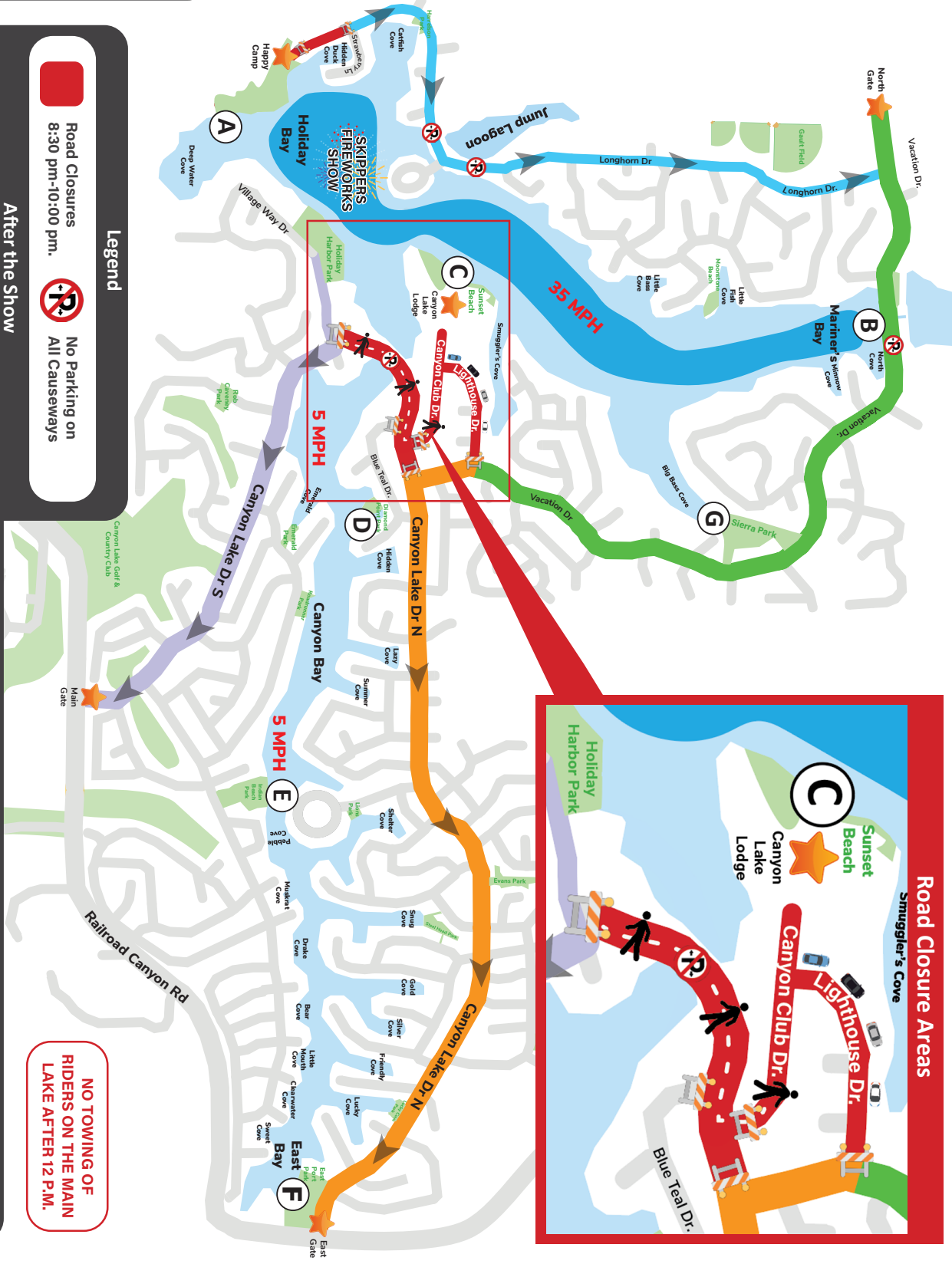
# Road Closures & Traffic Detours in Canyon Lake July 4, 2019

**Parks & Beaches**  
 Open at 6 a.m. on the morning of the July 4. No personal possessions are allowed to be at parks and beaches after closing July 3. Any belongings unattended are at your own risk.

**Emergency Locators (A-G)**  
 Points of reference in the event of an emergency upon dialing 9-1-1 and giving letter location to operator.

**Closing Longhorn @ Strawberry Lane at 2 p.m.**  
 Only residents of that section of Longhorn Drive, guests of those residents (including other Canyon Lake residents), and paying Happy Camp guests with a colored pass can go through. **All traffic (including pedestrians) is stopped at 8:30 p.m. to the campground.**

**City Code Enforcement & Marine Patrol**  
 Officers will be enforcing the 'Fallout Zone' perimeter as directed from Fire Tech until after the fireworks show and Fire Marshal gives the all clear. \*No egress/ingress to Hidden Duck Cove (Strawberry Lane Cove) at 8:30 p.m. until end.
